**Brighton & Hove (Preston Park) Various Restrictions Order 2012
Amendment Order No.* 20** (TRO-8-2013)**

Statement of Reasons

In May 2012 following public consultation the decision was made at the Environment Transport and Sustainability Cabinet Member Meeting to implement parking controls in Preston Park. At the time it was agreed that the scheme would be reviewed after six months. The parking scheme has addressed the main concern of the Park being used as a long-term car park by non park users. The review has identified that the scheme is generating more surplus than anticipated and the proposed changes reduce the costs for park users.

Reducing the times that charges apply will mean that many park users will be able to park free of charge, including many of the sports clubs that have fixtures at the weekends or weekday evenings. Any surplus income generated would be regarded as additional funding ring fenced to the park.
